



FROM THE BISC BOARD OF MANAGEMENT

You will all be aware of the protective measures being put in place at various establishments so that the spread of COVID-19 is contained, and operation of these facilities can continue, albeit in a restricted way.

The BISC Board of Management wish to advise that it is not possible to maintain a sterile facility, especially as our small workforce are volunteers, but with the cooperation of all clubs and members, we can continue to use BISC in a safe manner.

WE ASK THAT:

- The target monitors are wiped with alcohol-based wipes, before and after use.
- The shooting mats are sprayed with disinfectant, before and after use.
- The benchrest tables are wiped, before and after use.
- Social distancing guidelines are adhered to, by using every second firing point.
- Laptops and printers be wiped, before and after use.
- Shared equipment be wiped or sprayed, before and after use.
- The surfaces in the kitchen are wiped down, before and after use.
- All shooters and visitors wash hands and maintain appropriate separation from one another (minimum 1.5 metre)
- When signing Range Registers and Form 33s, use hand sanitiser before signing.
- Members bring their own pen.

Members be advised not to come to BISC if:

- you have any illness;
- have had contact with someone who has been overseas in the past 14 days;
- you have had contact with any person diagnosed with or suspected of having COVID-19 in the past 14 days;
- you are required to self-isolate due to their travel history

We will have supplies of hand sanitiser, disinfectant and wipes at the range tomorrow
